How much does this service cost?

This quote is for estates where:

- There is a valid will
- There is no more than one property
- There are no more than three bank or building society accounts
- There are no other intangible assets
- There are 1-2 beneficiaries and no trusts arise
- There are no disputes between beneficiaries on division of assets. If disputes arise this is likely to lead to an increase in costs
- There is no inheritance tax payable and the executors do not need to submit a full account to HMRC
- There are no claims made against the estate

On average, estates that fall within this range are dealt with within 12 months. Typically, obtaining the Grant of Probate takes 16 weeks. Collecting assets then follows, which can take between 2-6 months (excluding a property sale). Once this has been done, we can distribute the assets, which normally takes 4-8 weeks.

Breakdown of costs

- Legal fees £6,500
- VAT on legal fees £1,625
- Disbursements (approx. £613 in total):
 - Probate court fee of £273 (approx.)
 - Anti money laundering search fee £15 plus VAT per executor
 - Bankruptcy-only Land Charges Department searches (£2 per beneficiary)
 - Section 27 Notice to Creditors placed in The Gazette and a local newspaper of approximately £150 - £250 + VAT.
